一、考试基本要求

本考试大纲适用于报考深圳大学教育硕士专业的硕士研究生入学考试。《综合英语》是为招收教育硕士而设置的具有选拔功能的水平考试，主要目的是测试考生对英语各项基本技能以及英语教育相关理论的掌握程度。要求考生掌握阅读理解能力、语法知识和运用能力、翻译能力，学术阅读和写作能力。

二、考试内容和考试要求

(一) 英语知识能力部分考试要求：

1. 掌握英语听、说、读、写、译能力；
2. 能根据所阅读内容，准确概括和归纳原文中心思想；
3. 能完成中等难度的英汉-汉英互译；
4. 能在规定时间内完成英语议论文写作，语言表达正确、观点鲜明、说理透彻并举逻辑性；
5. 能表达对自己教学的反思和评价。

(二) 英语教学专业知识部分考试要求：

1. 能够理解和阅读中等难度的英语学术文献，并能归纳其中心思想和进行反思；
2. 理解英语教学相关术语，掌握一定的英语教育基础理论知识；
3. 具有较好的英语学术写作能力。

主要题型可能有：语法知识题、阅读理解、英汉-汉英互译、学术问答题和英语议论文写作等。试卷满分为 150 分。
