#### 一、考试基本要求

考试宗旨：检验考生词汇、阅读理解、欣赏和书面表达等方面英语综合运用能力。

考试要求：

1. 能阅读英语书刊报纸，能辨别出文中的事实与细节，又能概括出全文主旨；理解其字面及隐含意义；
2. 能分析文章的篇章结构、写作目的、语言技巧、修辞手段及思想观点，并做出自己的评价；
3. 能用适当词语解释文中较难词语，包括解释文中长句及难句；
4. 能运用关于英语语言、文学、文化等方面的综合知识回答问题。

#### 二、考试内容和考试要求

考试内容：考试内容涵盖国内高校通用的精读与写作教材内容，兼及时事、政治、经济、文化及社会生活等方面英文报刊或网站的有关内容。

考试形式：客观试题与主观试题相结合、单项技能测试与综合技能相结合。

#### 三、考试基本题型(总分：150)

1. 词语替换：共 30 题，要求考生能将一篇正式文体中的词语用日常用语表达出来(30%)；
2. 完形填空：200 字左右短文，20 个空。要求考生根据上下文用适当的词语填空。该部分或提供选项，或不提供选项 (20%)；
3. 句子复述：1 篇短文，5 句划线的长句和难句。要求考生用自己的语言解释文章中的长句及难句 (20%)；
4. 阅读理解：3-4 篇阅读文章，共 20 多项选题。要求考生根据阅读内容选择适当答案 (50%)；
5. 基础知识：简答、解释、填空或选择与英语语言、文化有关的问题 (30%)；
6. 答题要求：全部答案要求写在答题纸上；写在试卷上的答案无效。
